Youth Confirmation is a formal Sacramental Ceremony

Ladies:

1. Dresses and skirts need to be loose and modest. They cannot be a tube top, or form fitting style of dress or skirt; slit cannot be higher than three inches above the knee.
2. Blouse/dress necklines must be modest and unrevealing and shoulders/back must be covered. Lingerie must not be visible.
3. Slacks, capris (mid-calf length) pants cannot be super low rising or midriff. No jeans/denim of any style or color.
4. Dress shoes or sandals only. (2" inches or lower) No beach flip-flops.
5. Neatly groomed hair – forehead should be clear for oil anointing.

Please note:

Ladies: Strapless necklines must be modest and not revealing. Extreme “bodycon” dresses are not permitted. Lingerie must not be visible. Skirt length must be at least fingertip length. Tennis shoes and flip flops are not permitted.

Gentleman:

1. Dress pants/slacks w/belt and cannot be low hanging or baggy.
2. No jeans/denim of any color or style.
3. Long or short sleeve dress shirt and tie, tucked in.
4. Dress shoes or deck shoes only. No sandals or tennis shoes.
5. Neatly groomed hair (including man buns) – forehead should be clear for oil anointing.

Please note:

Gentlemen: Collared shirt, tie, dress pants, belt and dress shoes. Tennis shoes and flip flops are not permitted. Jacket is optional.
